


Toe Fracture Discharge Advice



- You have fractured <u>one or more</u> bones in the lesser or Big toe.
- These types of fracture heal well in most cases without any problems.
- Toe strapping if provided can be removed after 2-3 weeks.
- It can be more comfortable to wear either hard soled boots or sandals, moving back into comfortable supportive shoes when pain and swelling allows.
- Pain and tenderness will settle but this can take up to 3 to 6 weeks.
- Most patients will have returned to a desk job at 3
 weeks and heavy manual work by 6 weeks after injury.
- If your symptoms fail to improve by 6 weeks please contact us using the fracture line.
