

## Paediatric Post-Operation Urology Complications/Concerns

This pathway is **ONLY** appropriate for children who have had operations at The Royal Oldham Hospital under the Pennine Acute Trust Urology team

ANY other paediatric Urological problems should be discussed with the surgical/ urology team at CMFT

Child presents to ED with complication of Urological operation

- ABC assessment
- Emergent treatment as required

Is specialist Urology input needed?

- Ensure safe to discharge
- Discuss with senior in ED
- Safety netting

Contact On-call Urology Middle grade/ Registrar based at NMGH (via switchboard)

Management options might include:  
Advice - GP review  
Advice - urgent OP appointment with urology  
Advice - review by urology department today

Urology to decide whether to see at NMGH OR at ROH

Discharge as per advice of Urology Middle grade (document name and advice given)

**NMGH**  
Transfer to ED  
Arrange transport as appropriate to condition of child

**ROH**  
Transfer to Children's Ward. To be managed under joint care of urology and paediatrics. (urology to liaise with paediatric medical team)
