Fever with any possibility of upper/lower respiratory tract focus.

Respiratory symptoms

Wheeze / asthma

SOB

Coughing

Patient with proven Covid contacts in community

Patients not meeting criteria above go to :

Observation & Assessment

Abdominal pain / constipation

Self harm /CAMHS

Poisoning/ Overdose

Chest pain / palpitations after ECG

Fever with definite non respiratory focus

Reduction in Urine output

CMA Cow's Milk Allergy / feeding problems

Fits/Faints/Funny Do/BRUE

Neonates/infants with Worried parents

Vomiting/ diarrhoea

Limping child no trauma

Head ache (Apyrexial)

Rash

UTC

Cuts/abrasions/wounds

Head injury

Long bone injury

Hands/feet injury

RTC

Dislocation

Burn

Dental

Facial injury
