What to refer to us (>= 16 years old):

- Limb/digital revascularisation
- Limb open fractures
- Soft tissue hand injuries - tendons/nerves/infections
- Complex bony hand injuries
- Cosmetically sensitive soft tissue injuries - e.g. lip lacerations, forehead lacerations, ear lacerations
- Complex Wounds - e.g. dog bites

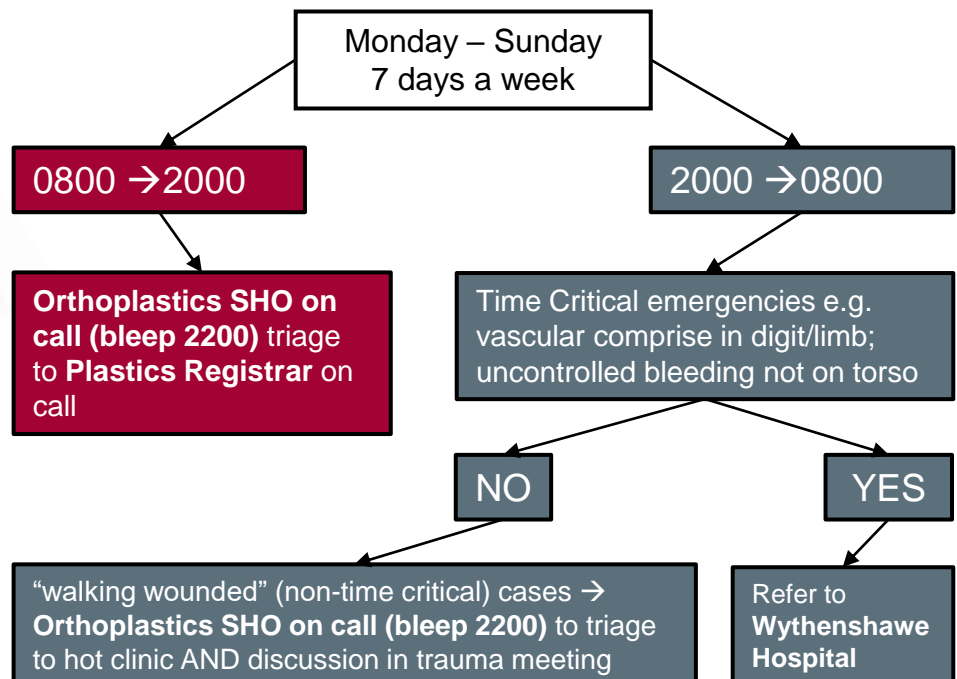

- Dedicated specialist therapists for nerve and tendon disorders

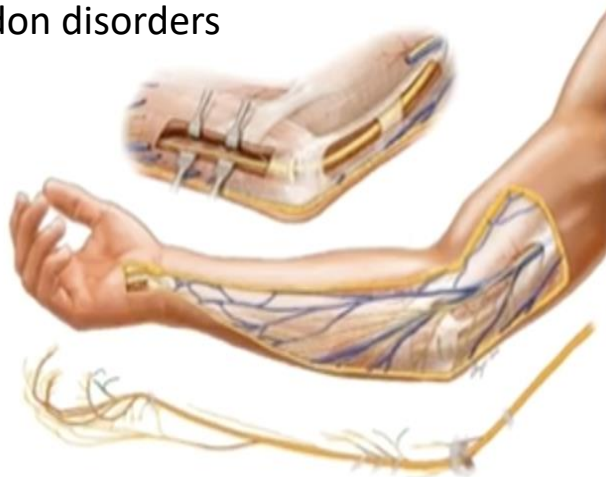
